.....GHG has joined the U.S. EPA Smartway Transport Partnership during the month of June 2015. Smartway Transport Partnership is an innovative collaboration between U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and industry which provides a framework to access the environmental and energy efficiency of goods movement claims. GHG will contribute to the Partnership savings of 144.3 million barrels of oil, \$20.6 billion in fuel cost, 61.7 MMT of carbon dioxide (CO2) 1,070,000 tons of nitrogen and 43,000 tons of particulate. This equates taking 10 million cars off the road. Carbon dioxide is the most common greenhouse gas, and nitrogen oxide is an air pollutant that contributes to smog. By joining SmartWay Transport Partnership, GHG Logistics demonstrates its strong environmental leadership and corporate responsibility to reduce our carbon foot print. The Partnership currently has over 3,000 Partners including shippers, logistics companies, truck, rail, barge and multimodal carriers
